Michael Blastic OFM is a Friar Minor of the Holy Name of Jesus Province, New York, NY. He is presently an Associate Professor and the Chair of Franciscan Theology and Spirituality Studies at the Washington Theological Union, Washington DC. He received his Ph.D. in Historical Theology from St. Louis University, St. Louis, Missouri. He is co-editor of a series of volumes of studies on the early Franciscan Sources being published by the Franciscan Institute, Saint Bonaventure University. His research and publications focus on the Writings of Francis and Clare of Assisi, the Franciscan Hagiographical Tradition, and the early Franciscan tradition of theology and spirituality. His lectures and workshops focus on how we can retrieve the commitments and practices of the Franciscan Tradition for our lives today.



Nancy Schreck OSF currently serves as the President of the Sisters of St. Francis, Dubuque, Iowa. Nancy has served in Mississippi for over twenty five years working primarily with at risk youth. She has also served as a presenter and facilitator for religious groups throughout the United States, as well as internationally.
