

Fr. Joseph Chinnici, OFM

Fr. Joseph Chinnici, OFM, a friar priest of the Province of Saint Barbara, is currently President of the Franciscan School of Theology, Oceanside, California. He has served in various capacities in the Order, working in formation, administration as a provincial minister, and professor of Church history. Joe has made several presentations to the Federation in the past and is best known amongst us for his work on the “Evangelical form of religious life.” He is the author of numerous works in American Catholicism and also the award winning *When Values Collide: the Catholic Church, Sexual Abuse and the Challenges of Leadership* (Orbis, 2010). Joe was chairman of the Secretariat for the Retrieval of the Franciscan Intellectual Tradition for ten years, the OFM Commission that has published the multi-volume Franciscan Heritage Series. Three years of work from this commission culminated in the first ever English exposition of the Franciscan moral vision in *Responding to God’s Love* (edited by Thomas Nairn), in which Joe wrote the chapter on “Framing Our Engagement with Society.”
