Mary Beth Ingham, CSJ is a sister of St. Joseph of Orange, CA. After completing her Doctoral studies in Medieval Philosophy at the University of Fribourg, Switzerland, Mary Beth taught for 25 years at Loyola Marymount University. She currently serves on her congregational leadership team and is Professor of Philosophical Theology at the Franciscan School of Theology, Oceanside, California. Mary Beth is a popular presenter and author of several books and numerous articles on the thought of Franciscan Master Blessed John Duns Scotus. Her monographs include *Scotus for Dunces: An Introduction to the Subtle Doctor*, *The Harmony of Goodness: Mutuality and Moral Living According to John Duns Scotus*, and *Rejoicing in the Works of the Lord: Beauty in the Franciscan Tradition*. She is currently working on a CFIT volume that compares the thought of Scotus with that of Thomas Aquinas.
