



The Camino of St Clare: Vignettes from her life

August 14 @ 9:30 am - 11:00 am PDT

Saint Clare of Assisi journeyed in and around the city of Assisi for most of her life. Beginning at her home near the Cathedral of San Rufino, we will retrace Clare's footsteps from home through the Moiano Gate to Saint Mary of the Angels where she met Francis and his companions to begin her life as a Franciscan.

- Part 1 is a tour and history of the five significant sites during the early stages of Clare's Franciscan journey.
- Part 2 is a deeper examination of Clare's spirituality, relationship to God and her sisters, and the miracles which she performed — all during her 40 years at San Damiano convent. Drawing upon resources from Clare's writings, the testimony of witnesses at her canonization, and historical references, we will hear memoirs that might have been from Clare's mother, Ortolana, and her sister, Beatrix. We will eavesdrop on a dialogue between Clare and Agnes of Prague, and hear what Clare herself had to say about the Pope ratifying her Rule of Life.
- Part 3 of *The Camino of St. Clare: Vignettes from Her Life* is a pictorial portrayal of events and miracles before, and after, Clare meets with Sister Death.
